

① The Themes/ Topics of both the Chatham Camera Club (“CCC”) and/or the Canadian Association for Photographic Arts (“CAPA”) competitions are listed in the Meeting Schedule section of the website. If you wish to enter images in these competitions, please follow these guidelines:

- Each member is allowed to submit two images in each CCC Competition, and one image in each CAPA competition.
- All images must be in .jpg format.
- All images must be sized no larger than 1024 pixels horizontally and 768 pixels vertically (it might be helpful to think of this as a Picture Frame with those dimensions (1024x768 and that your image must fit inside that frame).
- Images should be compressed using a setting of “10” if using “Adobe” programs or 90% if using FastStone.

② Images entered in CCC competitions should be named as follows (replace PaulS in the example with your first name and first letter of your last name, colour used for understanding here only):

PaulS-Hair1-2009 02 24.jpg (first image), **PaulS-Hair2-2009 02 24.jpg** (second image)

which translates to

First Name and First Letter of Last Name-Competition Theme (entry 1 and 2)-Date of Meeting at which the competition will be judged.jpg

③ Images entered in CAPA competitions should be named as follows (replace PaulS in the example with your first name and first letter of your last name, colour used for understanding here only):

PaulS-CAPA N-Yellow Bellied Sap Sucker-2009 02 24.jpg

which translates to

First Name and Initial-CAPA Theme (use N for Nature, O for Open)-Short title of image (use a maximum of four words)-Date of Meeting at which the competition will be judged.jpg

④ Images to be entered in either CCC or CAPA competitions are to be emailed to Paul Schmoltdt, Competition Manager. The deadline is 8:00pm on the Friday before the meeting at which the competition will be judged. A message acknowledging receipt of images will be sent.
